

**MINTUES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
OF THE AUGUSTA SCHOOL DISTRICT #10
October 20, 2009**

The Augusta Board of Education met in regular session at 6:30 PM on Tuesday, October 20, 2009, in the administrative offices. James Harston presided over the meeting. Members present were Debbie Briscoe, Janice Collier, Amanda Hanna, and Willie Powell. Katina Briscoe and Buddy Porter were absent. Superintendent Richard Blevins was also present.

James Harston opened the meeting with a prayer.

The board approved the minutes of the September 21, 2009, regular meeting as presented without reading.

James Harston welcomed the visitors.

Elsie Chestnutt, ACPEA representative, discussed Library Night activities that were held the first part of October and American Education Week will be November 16 – 20, 2009.

Pat Perusich, PPC representative, addressed the board. She presented a request that was submitted to the PPC concerning adding steps to the salary schedule for certified personnel, adding +15 to the bachelors and +15 to the masters. This was tabled until later in the year.

On a motion by Amanda Hanna and a second by Willie Powell the board ratified payment of the bills.

Richard Blevins presented the superintendent reports. He discussed the delivery of the 2 smaller buses and the large bus to be delivered on Friday, October 23, 2009.
